



DRIVING POLICY STATEMENT

CCI Students are not allowed to drive a car or motorcycle at any time during their stay in the United States with the exception of DRIVER'S EDUCATION PROGRAMS offered through the High School that the Student attends.

In order to take Driver's Education Training, the student must obtain permission from their Natural Parents, Host Parents, Area Representative and CCI Programs Director on the Driver's Education Permission Form available from the Area Representative.

This form must be sent to their home country and signed and then returned here to be signed by the Host Parents and others BEFORE permission will be given for the student to take Driver's Education.

CCI does NOT promise that the Student will receive a driver's license, and if the student does obtain a driver's license, it must be given to the Area Representative for keeping until such time as the Student leaves the country.

SEAT BELTS:

CCI requires that the student must wear a seat belt at all times when he/she is in an automobile, whether he/she is in the FRONT or the BACK seat. I understand that this is for the Students own safety and I agree to comply with this rule at all times.
